




Mārtiņš Aizpurvs "Goats on Shrooms"












Kristīne Kutepova

About the artist

Santa Paula's oil paintings are characterised by strong colours, smooth shapes, and ethereal and soft brushstrokes. The rhythms of contours and lines are wavy and airy, and the shapes of the depicted objects remind something biomorphic because the artist is very inspired by the mighty architecture of nature and its impeccability. Santa Paula (1999) lives and works in Riga, Latvia. In 2022 she graduated with a bachelor's degree from the Art Academy of Latvia Painting Department. Since 2020, she has organized two solo exhibitions named "Grava" (2020) and "P=0"; (2022), as well as participated in five group exhibitions in Riga, Jurmala and London.



About the artist


